**RESIDENTS INVITED TO VIEW LATEST PLANS FOR CONVOYS WHARF**

A public exhibition will be held on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July (12pm - 8pm) and Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July (10.30am - 2pm) for members of the local community to view and offer their feedback on revised proposals for Convoys Wharf.

Previously used by News International to import paper, Lewisham Council resolved to grant planning permission in 2005 for the regeneration of the site with a large mixed-use development, comprising new homes, employment space, and new community facilities. The latest proposals will see this largely vacant and underused brownfield site in Deptford brought back to life.

Since the beginning of public consultation in November 2009, local residents, groups and organisations, Lewisham Council and the GLA have been expressing their views on a range of issues relating to the development. Over the past few months, the development team has been working to take account of those views, where possible, and now hope to submit a planning application to the Council in the near future.

Raymond Chow, the Group Managing Director of Hutchison Whampoa Property, said:

“We remain committed to delivering this massive opportunity for Lewisham and the people of Deptford. I hope that residents will take this opportunity to visit our exhibition and talk to members of the development team. Through our public consultation, we have been listening to a range of views over the past few months and – where possible – have sought to incorporate those views into our final plans.”

The public exhibition will be held at Deptford Methodist Church and Mission, 1 Creek Road, SE8 3BT.
